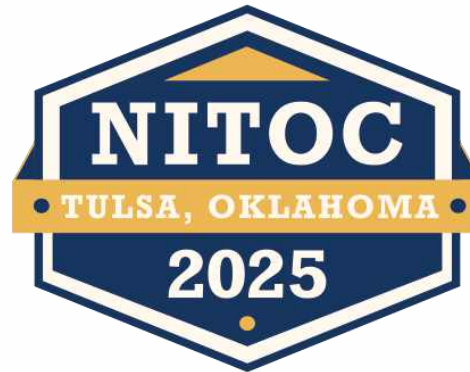

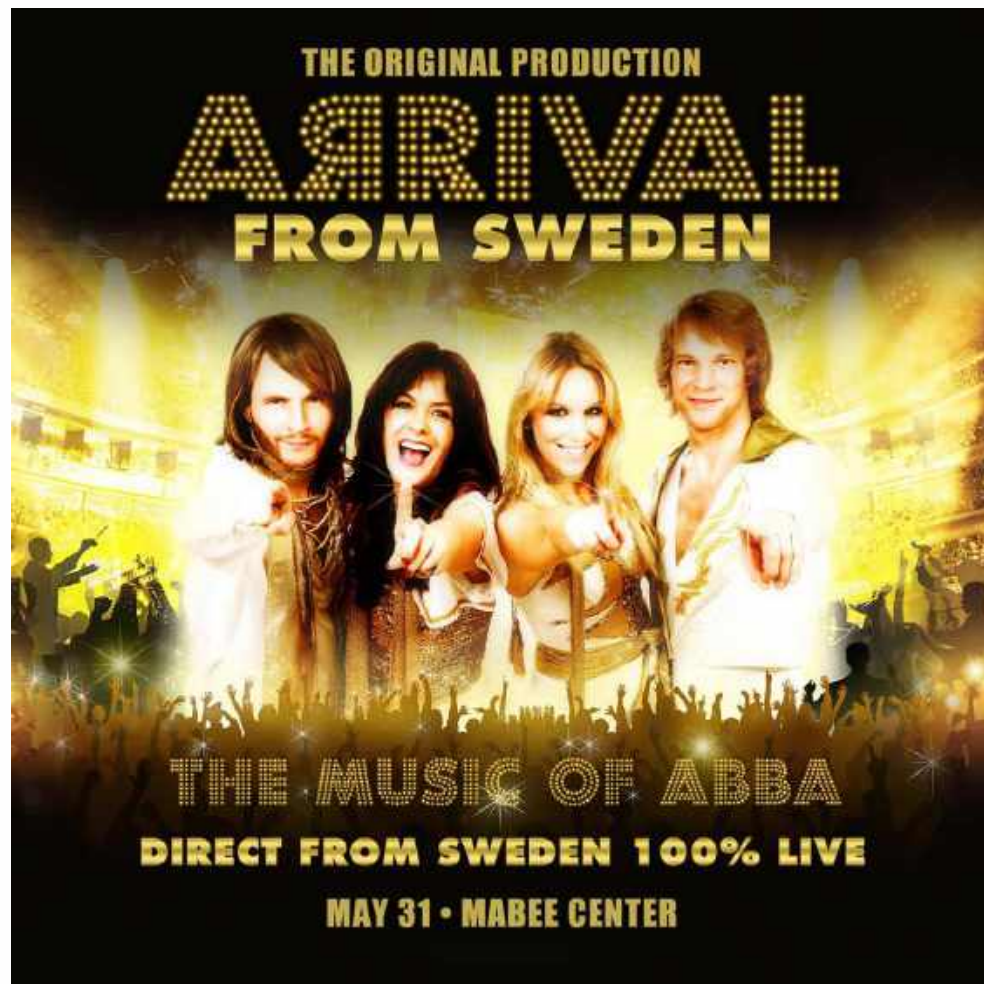

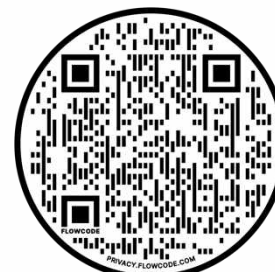


ORU Soccer Camp

MOTHER ROAD MARKET

Mother Road Market is a vibrant community space, allowing Tulsans and tourists alike to eat, sip, shop and enjoy different food and retail concepts, all under one roof. Find everything from tacos to ice cream, hot chicken to burgers, sushi to brunch! Enjoy nine holes of Route 66 themed mini golf and live music on the sprawling, enclosed patio, murals by local artists and additional shopping next door at the Shops at Mother Road Market. Kitchen 66, Tulsa's kickstart kitchen + food incubator, is housed at Mother Road Market and operates the Takeover Cafe, Landmark Food Truck, and General Store which are always showcasing new food entrepreneurs. Once you're done eating and shopping, head next door to Shops at Mother Road Market for more local Tulsa food and retail! The best part about coming to Mother Road Market is you are supporting local entrepreneurs!





PHILBROOK MUSEUM OF ART

Formerly the home of oilman Waite Phillips, Villa Philbrook was given to the city of Tulsa and restored to preserve the grandeur of the 1920s. Philbrook exhibits more than 8,500 works of art. The museum has 23 acres of exquisite English gardens and serves as many as 150,000 visitors annually.





GREENWOOD RISING

A state-of-the-art history center located at the heart of the historic Greenwood District honoring the legacy of Black Wall Street before and after the Tulsa Race Massacre of 1921, Greenwood Rising allows visitors to explore and connect with Greenwood District history through an immersive journey using projection mapping, holographic effects and environmental media.





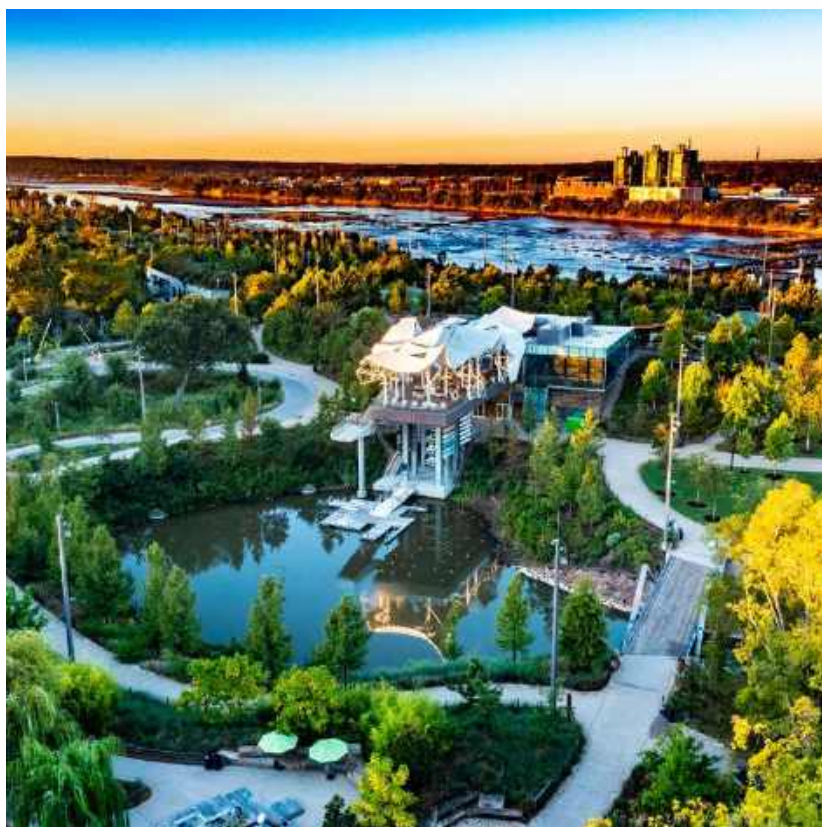
VISIT TULSA'S VISITOR CENTER

TULSA ZOO

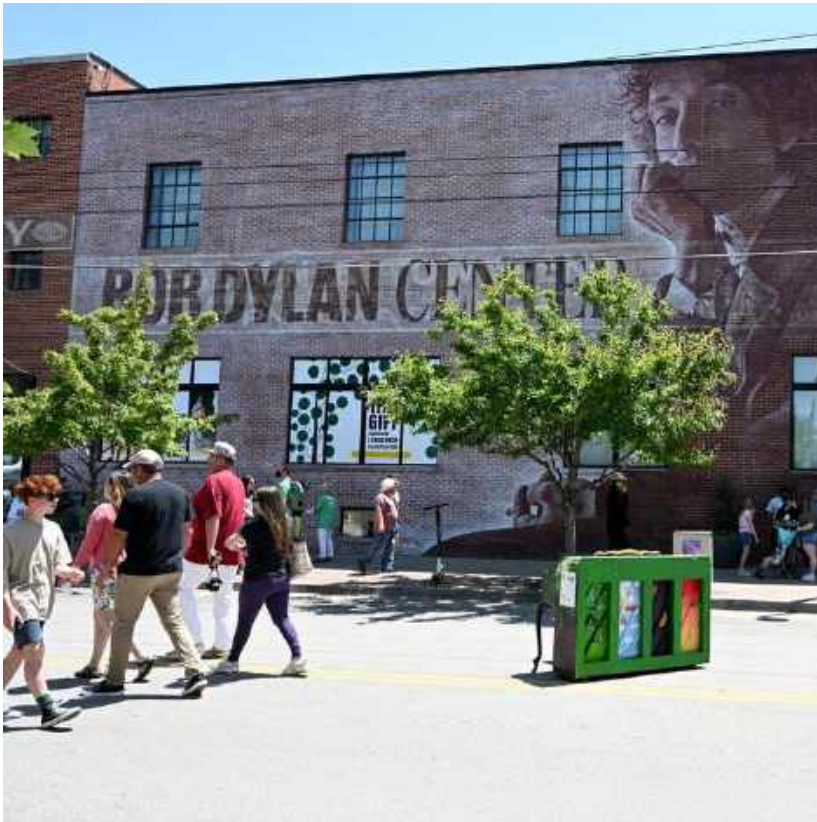
A fun and affordable destination where families can connect. Located in Mohawk Park, the Tulsa Zoo's beautiful 85-acres are home to more than 300 species (many rare and endangered in the wild). Visit immersive exhibits like the Mary K Chapman Rhino Reserve, learn more about your favorite animals during daily keeper chats, or enjoy the scenery during a trip on the train.





BOB DYLAN CENTER

The Bob Dylan Center offers unprecedented access to the creative life of one of America's most important and influential artists, the facility houses and exhibits more than 100,000 exclusive cultural treasures created and owned by Bob Dylan. The center provides programming, performances and special displays showcasing the artist's message and impact.





WOODY GUTHRIE CENTER

The Woody Guthrie Center is dedicated to preserving Woody Guthrie's body of work and celebrating his life and the continuation of his legacy. This educational facility provides resources to students, teachers, and academics about Woody Guthrie's important role in American history and his advocacy for social justice. The Woody Guthrie Center is more than a museum; instead, it is a center of investigation for inspiration. By providing examples of Woody's ability to use his creativity as a way of expressing the world around him, the Woody Guthrie Center hopes to encourage others to find their voices and the power that lies within the creative process.





THE CHURCH STUDIO

Formerly Grace Methodist Episcopal Church founded in 1915, Church Studio was purchased by legendary musician Leon Russell in 1972 who transformed the building into a recording studio. The birthplace of the Tulsa Sound was restored by owners Ivan Acosta and Teresa Knox, and opened in 2021 as world-class recording studio and event space on the vibrant Studio Row. Individuals and groups alike are invited to explore the collection of Leon artifacts and the various displays showcasing the studio's historical significance. Private docent-led tours are also available.





THE OUTSIDERS HOUSE MUSEUM

The Outsiders House Museum unveils a behind the scenes layer that everyone loves: the trivia, the untold yarns, the story behind the story. Stepping into the museum gives fans young and old a chance to stand in the living room where Ponyboy and Darry quarrel, visit the kitchen and recall all the talk about chocolate cake for breakfast, see Dallas Winston's leather jacket, hear about the mysterious disappearance and reappearance of Francis Ford Coppola's Director's Chair, see rare and never-before-seen photos, movie artifacts and more. Even if you're a longtime fan of The Outsiders, you're bound to see and learn something new.





OKLAHOMA AQUARIUM

The Oklahoma Aquarium is the largest indoor ocean in the four state region with thousands of aquatic creatures featured in more than 100 exhibits. It has the largest number of bull sharks in an aquarium setting with nurse sharks swimming alongside you and even overhead, as you walk through a unique, underwater tunnel. Visitors will be amazed by the incredible variety of other fish including seahorses, jellyfish and eels. From salt water to fresh water, this aquarium in the Tulsa suburb of Jenks features a dazzling array of water creatures.

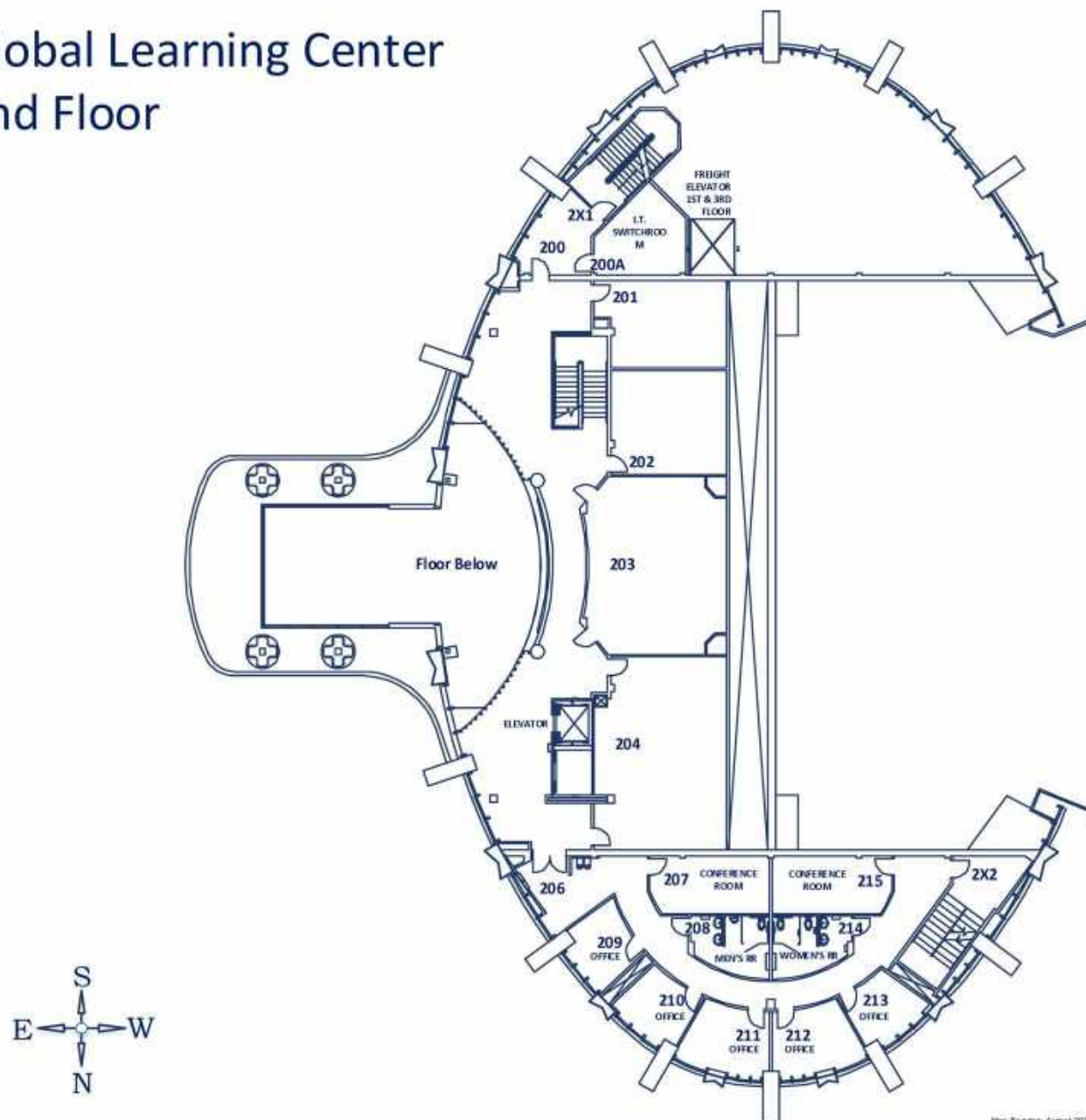

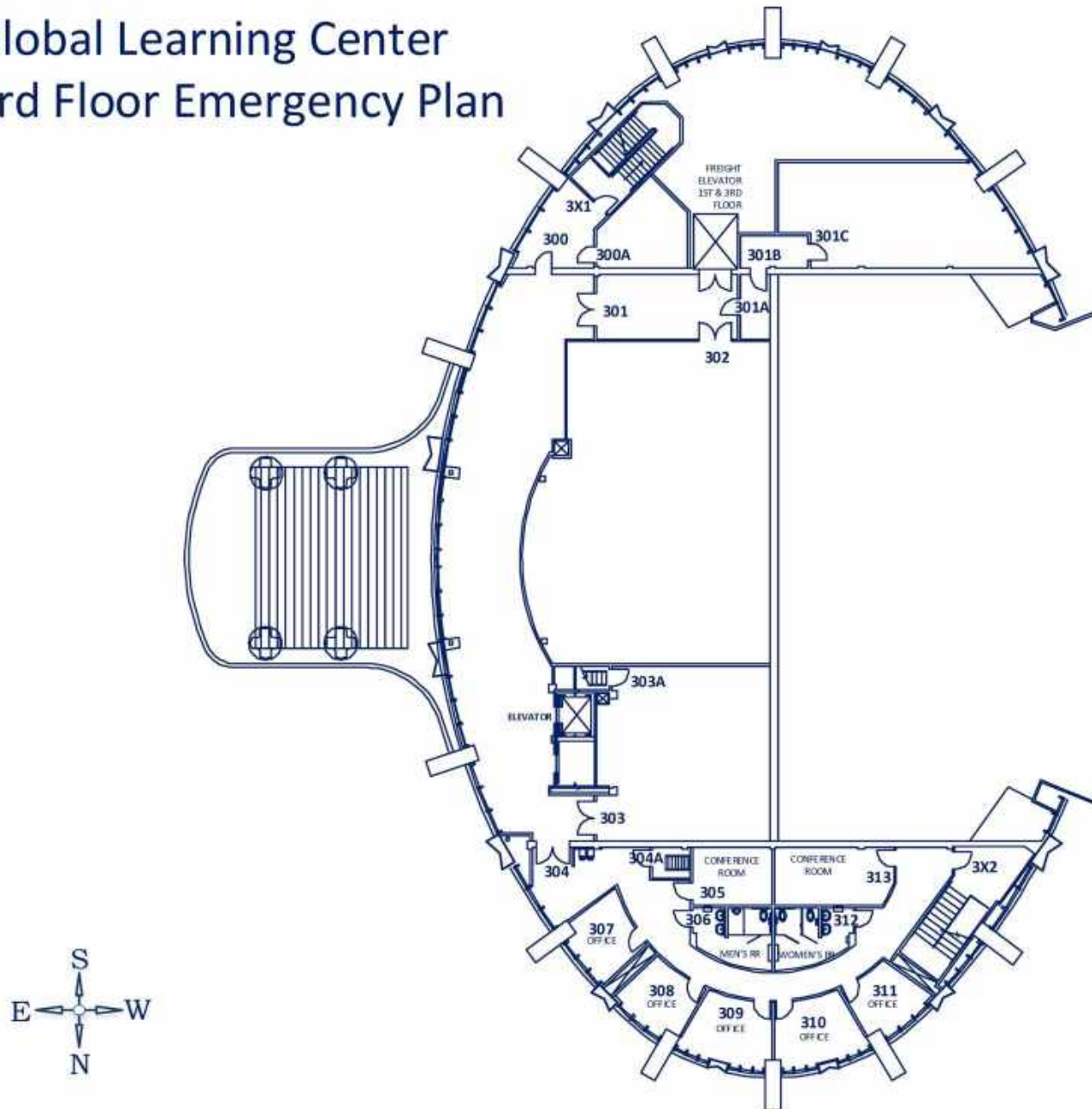
