## NITOC Safety and Security Procedures

Your safety is our top priority during NITOC. Please review and follow these procedures in the event of an emergency. Please review them with all family members.

### Fire Emergency

- Signal: Fire alarms will sound in all buildings.
- Action: Immediately evacuate the building. Do not wait or assume it is a drill.
- Note: Fire alarms are only used in the event of a fire and not for other types of emergency.

## Tornado Warning

- Signal: City-wide tornado sirens will sound.
- Action: Immediately proceed to a designated storm shelter location.

## Active Shooter / Campus Threat

- Notification: NITOC participants are encouraged to sign up for the ORU E-Alert System at <u>Emergency</u> <u>Alert Sign Up</u>
- Action: Follow the instructions provided in the alert system. These messages will come from ORU's Security Department. Guidance may include:
- Shelter in place
- Evacuate
- Lockdown
