APOLOGETICS

Sample Questions

Prep time: 2 minutes, Speak time: 5 minutes, No minimum

INTERPRETATION

- 1. Duo Interpretation will not be offered at this tournament.
- 2. You may use traditionally published literature, literature published on the internet, or original writing. Examples include: prose, poetry, short stories, plays, historical speeches, children's books.
- 3. Selections may be humorous, dramatic, or a combination of the two.
- 4. Media transcription from movies, television, or tape recordings are not allowed.
- 5. The title(s) and author(s) of the selection(s) must be introduced near the beginning of the speech.
- 6. No props, costumes, audiovisuals, or vulgar language is permitted.
- 7. Only your feet are permitted to touch the floor.
- 8. The speech must be memorized.

Speaking time: 7 minutes maximum. No minimum.



IMPROMPTU

- 1. You must pick three topics set out on the table by one of the judges.
- 2. You must choose one topic quickly as prep-time begins when you take the topics from the table. Please return the other two topics to the judge table.
- 3. The timekeeper will start the timer when the speaker draws. There are 3 minutes of prep time. Unused preparation time may not be added to the speaking time.
- 4. No outside sources may be brought into the room other than a blank piece of paper. You may write notes during prep-time, but you cannot use them during your speaking time.
- 5. The chosen topic paper may be held and quoted from during the speech, but no notes may be written on the chosen topic paper.
- 6. No visual aids or props may be used.
- 7. You must state your topic somewhere near the beginning of your speech.
- 8. Each speech should adhere to the chosen topic, while demonstrating originality and creativity.
- 9. You may not watch any other speakers before you, only those that compete afterwards.

Preparation time – Three (3) minutes.

Speaking time limit - Five (5) minutes maximum. No minimum time.

PLATFORM

- 1. The competitor may prepare a speech on any topic.
- 2. The speech may inform, entertain, inspire, or eulogize.
- 3. The speech must be an original work, written by the competitor.
- 4. The competitor must provide a script and a citation page (if needed) at each tournament. All sources must be cited in text and orally within the speech.
- 5. A maximum of 30% of the speech may consist of directly quoted material.
- 6. The script must be memorized and delivered as written in the script.
- 7. No props, audio, or visual aids may be used.
- 8. Gratuitous vulgarity is strictly prohibited.

Speaking time: 7 minutes maximum. No minimum.
